



Back to School Facts for the school year 2017-2018.

1. Physicals are needed for ... 1st entry into school such as Pre-K and Kindergarten, 6th, 9th as well as out of state transfers. A School physical will count as sports physicals, but ... a sports physical does not count as a school physical. Physicals are due by the first attendance day.
2. Immunizations... are needed typically in K, 6th, 9th and now 12th. This is also dependent on past vaccine history. Immunizations are due by the first day of attendance.
3. Eye exam ... is needed... for all children enrolling in K or first time entry in any public or private school beyond K, (i.e. grades 1-12).
4. Dental exam... is needed... by May of 2018 for grades Kindergarten, 2nd and 6th.
5. Lead test... is needed... one lead test is needed prior to first entry to school such as Pre-K or K. Please call Brown County Health Department with questions @ 217-773-2714.

Note: Required immunizations are continually updated to meet changing health needs

** Note: These immunization schedules are required by The State Board of Health which works under the advisement of the CDC, and ACIP recommendation. This is then put into effect by the Illinois State Board of Education.
